Rules/Conduct/Eligibility

The competition is open to all amateur skaters who are members in good standing with the USFSA and will be governed by the rules specified in the 2001-2002 USFSA Rulebook, except as noted. Skaters may enter events according to their age and test level as of January 4, 2002. Skaters may compete at one level higher than the skater's current test level. However, skaters may only enter one level per event (i.e. Juvenile Free Skating only and not Intermediate Free Skating also.) Pre-Preliminary through Pre-Juvenile skaters will be grouped according to age. The competition committee reserves the right to divide or combine any event if necessary and to cancel any event (with full refund of entry fee) due to lack of participants. Skaters must be 25 years of age or older as of January 4, 2002, to enter any Adult events.

Entries

All entries must be postmarked by midnight, January 4, 2002. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the competition committee with a \$25.00 late fee. Late entries may not appear in the program. All fees must accompany the entry form. Make checks payable to Lincoln Center Figure Skating Club (LCFSC). Please note that separate checks are required for entry fees, practice ice. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. **Refunds will not be issued unless the event is cancelled due to lack of entries except for rule 33.05 A in the USFSA Rulebook.** An event will be held if there are two or more competitors.

Video Photography

Video Photography will be available. Those interested in video taping for personal use are required to remain in the bleachers. Electrical outlets may not be used. Absolutely no flash photography is allowed during the warm-up or competition.

Facility

The competition will be held at the Hamilton Center Ice Rink in Columbus, Indiana. The ice surface is 85' x 200' with slightly rounded corners. A snack bar, skate shop and dressing rooms will be available during the competition. There is ample seating and parking.

Registration

The registration desk will be in the lobby. It will open 1 hour prior to competition on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and remain open through the last event each day. It will also be open Thursday during practice ice times. Please register promptly upon arrival. All tapes must be turned in at check-in and must be ready to play.

Music

All competitors' music must be on cassette tapes clearly labeled with the skater's name, club name and event marked on the side to be played. **Tapes must be turned in at check-in.** Tapes may be picked up at the registration desk following each event. Please remember to bring at least one back-up tape and have it available rink side.

Awards

Medals will be given to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places in all events. Ribbons will be given to 5th through 8th place. Awards presentations and official photos will take place in the lobby throughout the competition. Please report to the awards area promptly in competition attire and skates.

Team Trophies will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams.

Practice Ice

Practice Ice will be scheduled beginning Thursday evening and throughout the competition. A 30-minute pre-paid practice session is \$8.00. A 30-minute walk-on practice session will be \$10.00, if additional ice time is available. Practice schedules will be mailed with competition schedules to skaters who enclose a legal size, stamped, self-addressed envelope with their registration form. Practice Ice will be limited to 20 skaters per session. Practice Ice may be limited due to the number of requests.

Official Notices

An official bulletin board will be maintained in the lobby. Posting of schedules and announcements thereon shall constitute sufficient notice to competitors, coaches, chaperones and officials.

COMPULSORY MOVES

Eligibility is as described for Free Skating. Compulsory Moves may be skated in any order except where specified and will be skated without music. Skaters will be penalized for extra footwork or additional moves. An axel is considered a single jump, except where noted. Combination jumps may not have a change of foot or turn between jumps. Spins must be at least 4 revolutions, unless otherwise stated. Compulsory Moves will be skated on half the ice surface.

SPINS

An event to encourage and reward good spins. Eligibility is as described for Free Skating. Spins must be skated exactly as stated but may be skated in any order without music. Connecting moves may be included, such as short sequences of footwork and are for the sole purpose of maneuvering between spins and will not be judged. All levels will be skated on half the ice surface.

SHOWCASE

Skaters will provide their own music. The themes are open. Vocal music is allowed. The program shall stress creativity with an emphasis on musical interpretation and an overall artistic performance. Spins and jumps are allowed, but shall not be highlighted and shall be used only to emphasize the artistic quality of the program. Costumes are encouraged. Hand held props only. Props must be carried at all times. Eligibility is as described for Free Skating. One mark will be given.

Original Solo Dance (new event for Solo Dancers)

Similar general rules to the Original Dance for couples as applicable to a solo dancer. See SR10.01 in 2000-2001 USFSA Rulebook.

Rhythm: Tango or Paso or a combination of both

Duration: 2 minutes plus or minus 10 seconds.

Must include the following:

- 1) Step Sequence
 - a) Circular - utilizing the full width and placed in the center of the ice surface
 - b) Straight Line - extending the full length down the mid line of the ice surface
 - c) Diagonal - extending from corner to corner diagonally across the ice surface

note: Step Sequences should include a variety of footwork steps and turns with at least one (1) Twizzle (revolutions optional). No jumps, stops or retrogressions are permitted during the step sequence.

- 2) Spin
One dance spin, but no more, with a minimum of 2 revolutions on one foot after which a change of foot with further revolutions are optional.

OTHER REGULATIONS:

Stops: Two (2) are permitted (except in the step sequence) to express the character of the music. One may be at the beginning of the program and one during the program. Duration of stops - 5 seconds. Stops are **not** mandatory but, if used, must be as described above.

Jumps: small half revolution jumps are permitted (except in the step sequence) to express the character of the music. No more than two (2) jumps permitted.

Music: Only music with rhythmic beat throughout may be used. Vocal music is **NOT** permitted.

Marking: Two (2) marks as described for couples OD with the exception of unison not being a factor. See SR 1-11.

Low Original Dance - Pre Juvenile through Intermediate (see couples requirements)

High Original Dance - Novice through Senior (see couples requirements)

Initial and final rounds in Couples Dance event will be combined to determine final placement. The final round placement will be used to break all ties. All skaters will compete in initial and final rounds.

Entrants must be 25 years of age or older on January 4, 2002. Skaters may skate up one test level. Depending on the number of Adult entries, the Competition Committee reserves the right to combine levels if necessary.

Combination jumps may not have a change of foot or turn between jumps. An axel is considered a single jump, unless otherwise stated. All levels will be skated on half the ice surface.
