

Local judge Margaret Macaulay suffered a serious fall last weekend during the competition at Fraser, breaking her hip. Many of you have expressed concern about her well-being. This is the information that her daughter Colleen gave me (18-Jul-2007)

Hi Don,

Mom's surgery on Sunday at 11:30 a.m. went very well. The fracture was stabilized with a metal plate and some screws. The surgeon was very pleased with the results and Mom's whole frame of mind through the process. Pain seems to be minimal for her. Today, she took a short walk, assisted by a walker, down the hallway for about fifty feet and back. The physio's are very surprised and pleased with her progress. Mom wants to thank everyone for their thoughts, sentiments and prayers. Her hospital stay will likely go through to this Friday. They may be looking at three or four days of rehab at the hospital following her release.
